## Suggested Formats Table A: Baseline Data on the Trainee Pool— Trainee Characteristics

- NIGMS no longer requires Training Table 6A in its Institutional Predoctoral T32 training grant applications.
- Although Table 6A is not required, all applicants must provide the number and average for the past five academic years of the training grant eligible candidates who applied to, were admitted to, and matriculated into the training program or department described in the application.
- Applicants are encouraged to use Suggested Formats Table A for single department applications and both Suggested Formats Table A and Suggested Formats Table B for applications with multi-departmental or multi-organizational structures. The Suggested Formats Tables are found on the NIGMS website.

## Suggested Formats Table A: Baseline Data on the Trainee Pool— Trainee Characteristics

- Rationale: The application must provide baseline data on the characteristics of the trainee pool. The data must reflect the training grant eligible individuals who further the goals of the proposed training program. The data serve as the basis for review of planned activities, including recruitment.
- The number of training grant eligible candidates will be used to determine the appropriate budget and number of funded positions.
- Applicants are encouraged to report on the categories described in the <u>Notice of NIH's Interest in Diversity</u> or in the <u>NIH Trainee Diversity Report</u>. NIGMS will use the data provided in a manner consistent with applicable law.

How do I avoid the inclusion of Table 6A?

 To avoid the inclusion of Table 6A in a training data table set generated via xTRACT, applicants should omit the "start year of the most recently completed academic year" when prompted in the Applicants/Entrants Section.

The resulting PDF will then exclude Table 6A.

Where do Suggested Formats Tables go in the application?

- If an applicant uses the Suggested Formats Tables to structure the baseline data of the trainee pool, then upload this information as an attachment per the guidance found in Section IV of the Notice of Funding Opportunity.
- Suggested Formats Tables must not be included in the Data Table section.
